Purpose:	To evaluate contestant's entry level basic health care skills and knowledge and to recognize outstanding students for their excellence and professionalism.
Clothing:	Scrub top and bottom with no identifying names or logos on any part of the uniform. Non-skid white or black shoes. Hair pulled up and off the shoulders and face, and no artificial nails.

SCOPE OF CONTEST:

Competitors will be required to test their skills in the following areas:	Knowledge Performance: Written exam of 25 multiple choice questions. Topics assessed may include but are not limited to: communication skills, infection control procedures, law and ethics, patient care, emergency practices, and diseases and disorders. Skill Performance: Contestants will demonstrate their basic knowledge of health care skills. Topics that will be assessed may include but are not limited to: denture care, elasticized stockings, infection control, unoccupied bed making, change a dry dressing using non-sterile technique, change a gown with weak side, vital signs, and height & weight.
