Contest:	CPR & First Aid
Purpose:	CPR and First Aid provides members with the opportunity to gain knowledge and skills required for first aid and basic life support. This event aims to inspire members to be proactive future health professionals and be equipped with the skills to provide immediate, lifesaving actions in the absence of emergency services.
Clothing:	Contest appropriate clothing. Students will not be penalized for clothing unless it is a safety violation.

Equipment and Material:

Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by Host School:

- 1. Hand sanitizer
- 2. Gloves
- 3. CPR Mannequins (adult & infant)
- 4. Bath blanket
- 5. Tourniquet

Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by the Contestant:

- 1. Watch with second hand
- 2. Photo ID
- 3. Roller gauze or other similar materials to tie or anchor splints in place
- 4. Bandaging materials as selected by competitor (should include sterile gauze squares, roller bandages, nonstick sterile dressing)
- 5. Bag mouth device (adult)
- 6. Biohazard bag
- 7. Cell phone (for simulating 911 call)
- 8. 1 pair of scissors
- 9. Adhesive tape

Competitors will be expected to demonstrate their skills by completing the following tasks - skills scenarios demonstrating first aid and CPR. There will be a 3-hour time limit for test completion.
