Contest:	Automotive Refinishing Technology
Purpose:	To test skills related to the refinishing of collision damage.
Clothing:	Contest appropriate clothing (safety glasses, work boots, work pants, school appropriate shirt). Students will not be penalized for clothing unless it is a safety violation.

Equipment and Material:

Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by Host School:

- Spray guns
- PPG technician pages for all paint materials to be used
- Clearcoat/Hardener/Reducer and related materials
- 1 Qt mixing cups
- Tape and paper for masking
- PPG paint chip books for color code identification
- PPG variance deck

Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by the Contestant:

- Safety glasses
- Charcoal Respirator
- Sanding dust mask
- · Appropriate gloves for refinishing tasks
- Paint suit

Scope of Contest

Student will demonstrate skills in:

- Applying clear coat to a provided fender that has been base coated. Clear being used will be PPG Shopline JC630.
- Masking 18" around one panel on vehicle in preparation for refinishing process.
- Identify color code on provided vehicle.
- Identify closest matching color variance.
- Students must complete an ASE style test.

Additional Information

- Contestants are not permitted to talk to the judges, or other contestants about use of equipment, products, or how to accomplish any tasks before or during the competition.
- It is difficult to list all tools necessary for completing the refinishing competition. Feel free to bring any tools you might see necessary to use during the competition.
- No cell phones or other devices are allowed to be present during the competition. If they are
 present the competitor will be disqualified.
