Purpose:	To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the Nail Technology
Clothing:	Contestant Attire: White top/blouse/shirt with black dress pants or appropriate length skirt, black socks or black/nude seamless hose, and black leather closed- toe shoes. Model Attire: Businesslike white collarless blouse, black slacks or appropriate length skirt, black socks or black/nude seamless hose and black closed toe shoes. Must be professional dress, no jeans or yoga pants.

Provided by the Contestant:	 Live model wearing no jewelry on hands White terry towels-no holes or stains Disposable towels for table No mix and match of chemicals. (The same manufacturer must be used for acrylic steps. All gel overlay products must be from the same manufacturer.) All necessary items to complete 2 French sculptured acrylic nails (white and pink)

Note: Dappen dishes must have covers
 All necessary items to complete 2 light cured gel overlays,
including the UV light.
All items to complete 4 flat nail art nails with a theme (may
include lacquer, polish, paint, and Topcoat)
Note: No premade items may be used
• A typed description of the nail art theme. Due at registration
in an 8.5 x 11 plastic sleeve
• All items to complete 5 nails with the application of basecoat,
2 coats of dark red polish and a topcoat
Water dispenser
 Portable kit to transport items to contest area.
• Blood spill kit
 One gallon bag for disposal of trash
 Safety goggles for competitor and model
 All items necessary to complete contest in a safe and
sanitary manner
There will be a kit check at the start of the contest. If a
contestant forgets a chemical or tool necessary to perform a
component of the contest, they will not be allowed to
participate in that portion of the contest and will receive a
score of zero. For safety reasons borrowing products from
other contestants will NOT be allowed.

Competitors will be required to test their skills in the following areas:	 There will be a 3-hour time limit for the competition completion. 20 QUESTION TEST- (20 min) on any aspect of nails will be given at the end of the competition. The best score/grade will be used to break a tie if it exists. Initial Preparation/Table Set Up Set up items needed for the specific contest application in progress. Time will be allowed between each contest to reset the table. Cleanliness and organization will be evaluated
	 Cleanliness and organization will be evaluated throughout the contest. Infection control and safety procedures will be evaluated throughout the contest. All products and solutions must be properly identified with the manufacturers original packaging and label. Required tools and products must be accounted for and professionally organized. No jewelry is to be worn during the competition (rings, watches, or bracelets)
	 Acrylic Application (30 minutes) Complete 2 fingers of one hand with acrylic application using forms, NO TIPS, two tone French manicure pink and white technique (white powder for the free edge and pink for the nail plate) Evaluation is based on: Initial degree of difficulty – based on the condition and characteristics of the natural nails. Acrylic application-product control, no bubbles, smile line, c-curve arch, thinness, and continuity. Finished appearance- smoothness, shape, and length consistent and proportionate to hand, finished appearance with a high gloss shine product close to the cuticle but not touching the skin.
	 Tip and Light Cured Gel Overlay (30 minutes) Complete 2 fingers on the same hand as the acrylic application. Natural colors or white tips applied and then overlaid with a light cured gel system. The contestant may use any combination of white, pink, or clear sculptured gels. GEL POLISH is NOT allowed. The following will be evaluated: Tip application: fit and alignment Consistent length and shape The length looks balanced on the model's hand The edges of the nail are smooth, even, and clean. The smile lines are clean, symmetrical, and consistent. The gel product free from air bubbles and pits The gel product is close to the cuticle, but not touching the skin.

 The color of the product is consistent The skin is free from products The top and bottom surfaces of the nails are smoothed and contoured. The finished appearance complements the models' hands and there are no scratches. The nails are cleaned (free of dust) with a high gloss shine.
 Background color for Nail Art Application (10 minutes) 1. Background color is applied to the 4 nails on the hand with acrylic and gel overlay. 2. 10 minutes to apply polish
 Red Polish Application (20 minutes) A dark red polish is applied to pre-manicured hand. (Hand not used for acrylic and gel overlays) 20 minutes to apply base coat, 2 coats of red polish and topcoat to all 5 nails The following will be evaluated: Coverage Neatness Evenness Cuticle involvement
 Wearable Flat Nail Art (45 minutes) Display your TYPED Description of the nail art theme IN A PLASTIC SLEEVE. Diagrams or displays of nail art design may be used however, these are limited to the finished product and cannot be step-by-step instructions. Nail art is to be applied to 4 nails that have been previously polished with a background color completion time 45 minutes. A specific theme is to be carried out through all 4 nails The following will be evaluated: Creativity Theme Follow through of theme Color coordination Level of difficulty Complexity of design Precision Neatness Clarity Typed description of theme in a plastic sleeve

Anything else competitors may need to know:	 <u>Students will not be permitted to use the Internet or</u> printed materials for reference.
	 Safety Requirements All implements and supplies used must be clean and sanitary. The contestant is expected to demonstrate sanitation and infection control before beginning procedures. All contestants must follow infection control and safety procedures throughout the contest.
	 ITEMS NOT ALLOWED CELL PHONES or other electronic devices, including SMART WATCHES. If found on the contestant or model the contestant will be disqualified. Oils, lotions or buffing crème No 3-D nail art, air brushing, add-ons, or premade materials (including gems, feathers, skins, rhinestones, glitter, threads, fabrics, foils, beads, tape, decals, stencils, cast molding) Topcoat and base coats (except for nail art) No gel polishes Free edge or white tip Electric drills Tip blenders
	 taken will occur for the following: A rule not followed with NO exceptions! Leaving the competition area before a completion of the model without an escort (applies to the contestant and the model) Any product that appears to be altered There will be no conversation between contestant and model or any talking on the floor once the competition has started. Safety violations that put the contestant or model at risk Missing required tools or chemicals Both the contestant and the model should exhibit professionalism in their appearance and behavior. Contestants are not permitted to touch their models after they have been seated in the competition area, until the competition begins. The host school and judges reserve the right to check all toolboxes and/or materials prior to the contest. Any tools deemed questionable and would give an unfair advantage to a contestant will not be permitted and will be discarded prior to the start of the competition.
