Scope of Contest

Competitors will be expected to demonstrate their skills by completing the following tasks-written test, measure internal engine parts and compare to spec, parts and tool identification test, diagnose and repair engine no start condition, repair and replace starter pull rope, demonstrate knowledge of use of digital multimeter and complete basic electrical measurements. Complete a repair order with parts markup and sales tax. Total time limit for completion is 2 hours 15 minutes.
