<b>Contest:</b>	<b>Cosmetology under 500 hours</b>

<b>Purpose:</b>	To evaluate each contestant's preparation for employment and to recognize outstanding students for excellence and professionalism in the field of <b>Cosmetology under 500 hours</b> .  (The competitor may not exceed 500 hours as of our State Leadership and Skills Conference on April 3, 2024.)
<b>Clothing:</b>	Contestants: White top/blouse/shirt, black dress slacks, black socks, and black leather, work, or dress shoes.  Must be professional dress, no jeans or yoga pants.

## SCOPE OF CONTEST:

**Competitors will be required to test their skills in the following areas:**

1. 20 Question test (20 minutes) on Level 1 Cosmetology will be given at the start of the competition. The best score/grade will be used to break a tie if it exists.
2. 5 minute set up
3. **Haircut (45 minute )** Create a Zero (0) degree haircut Finished length must be at least 7 inches. Must remove 1 inch of hair from entire head.
4. **Daytime Style (45 minute )** Using mannequin with the completed Zero (0) degree haircut blow dry and style. Movement and volume should be created with the round brush and/or curling iron (No spring iron curling irons).

If found on the contestant, then contestant will be disqualified.</li></ul> <p><b>Special Instructions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All rules followed</li><li>• No Talking and professionalism is expected</li><li>• It is impossible for the host schools to list all the tools you may have instructed your students to use when performing certain tasks. Feel free to bring additional tools you feel might be required to work on the project mentioned in the scope of the contest.</li><li>• The host schools and judges reserve the right to check all tool boxes and/or tools and materials prior to competition. Any tools we feel give the contestant (in their opinion) an unfair advantage will not be permitted.</li><li>• Contestant may not leave the contest site until they are dismissed.</li></ul>
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
